## An Order of Worship for the Day of Repentance

(The 1856 Lutheran Agenda outlined two orders of service for a Day of Repentance. This day normally took place on the Friday after the last Sunday of the church year. Two orders were provided: one for the morning and one for the afternoon. Note the flexibility provided to each local congregation to choose fitting Scripture readings, hymns, and prayers.)

## Morning:

- 1. Hymn: "Kyrie, God Father in Heav'n Above" (LSB 942)
- 2. Psalm, Prayer, reading of a selected passage from the Old Testament
- 3. General hymn of repentance (see LSB 418, 419, 423, 435, 440)
- 4. Reading from the New Testament
- 5. Hymn: "Lamb of God, Pure and Holy" (LSB 434)
- 6. Ex corde prayer by preacher
- 7. The Lord's Prayer
- 8. The Sermon
- 9. The Litany (LSB 288)
- 10. Closing Hymn

## Afternoon:

- 1. Sing a hymn of repentance
- 2. Read a Biblical selection
- 3. Hymn: "Lamb of God, Pure and Holy" (LSB 434)
- 4. Sermon
- 5. A penitiential prayer
- 6. Litany and the Lord's Prayer
- 7. Closing prayer, Blessing and hymn
