God has blessed us with resiliency at LEAH Downtown Academy. While we were on the verge of closing due to pandemic financial constraints, God provided us with a second chance to thrive and we are grateful. Our enrollment stands at 110 students today up from 83 students a year ago with more children scheduled to start in the weeks and months ahead.

Last week at chapel, we talked about roller coasters and how sometimes we are up and sometimes we are down. Sometimes we are excited and sometimes we are scared. We did roller coaster role play and compared the highs of a birthday party to the lows of a tummy ache. Through it all, God is with us. (I always pray our staff gets just as much encouragement and hope from chapel as the children do.) Fast forward two days. One of our teachers and eight of her students got stuck in an elevator at school when the power went out. As the teacher calmed the children, one of the children....let me repeat that... one of the children, a three year old, reminded the teacher that God is always with us. Prompted by the student's comment, she reminded them that just like we discussed at chapel...God is with us when we are up and when we are down and even when we are stuck.

By the way, the power came back on just before the fire department arrived and the children were able to exit the elevator without incident.

Almost a week later, firemen brought their cool red truck to our school and taught us a bit about fire safety. As the firemen wrapped up their presentation, they asked the children if they had any questions. A four year old raised her hand with what is typical... a statement rather than a question. She proclaimed to the firemen, "remember that God is always with you."

We are so thankful that God has allowed us to continue in this work of raising up a generation of missionaries through early childhood at LEAH Schools Downtown Academy in the heart of Downtown Houston.
