Spreading the Good News at Texas State University San Marcos

Jessica and CJ have been leading a continuous monthly effort to spread the good news of Christ at Texas State University San Marcos. Their latest outreach took place on May 1st, just before the end of the school year. This endeavor has proven invaluable not only for the students of San Marcos but also for their own personal growth in the Lord.

Through the Holy Spirit's guidance, their dedication, and the support of other volunteers, including Pastor

Jerrel Hein, they have effectively reached students from various religious backgrounds. Over the past year, they have engaged in deep conversations with at least two hundred individuals, spanning nearly every category of religious and non-religious people—from Mormons and Muslims to Hindus and Pagans. Some of these conversations have lasted for over an hour.

Many of those they have spoken to remain in contact and have even changed their perspectives about God. This ministry has taught them humility, patience, and wisdom in understanding different viewpoints. The fruits of their labor are evident and abundant.

However, they face a significant challenge. As Jesus said, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few." They do not have enough evangelists to handle the growing number of students eager to talk with them, often resulting in lines forming to get a chance to speak. Despite this, Jessica and CJ continue to trust in the Lord's provision and remain dedicated to their mission at Texas State University San Marcos.
