Overflowing with Hope: The Journey of Faith from Lubbock to Farwell

Lubbock is called the "Hub City" because of its location and the fact that many towns on the South Plains travel to Lubbock for various reasons. Some speculate that this name came about because it was a "train hub" back in the era of train travel. Regardless, it still holds its name today.

Hope Lutheran Church and School is located in Lubbock and is a growing and thriving ministry in Area A. In the early 2000s, Hope attracted families from Farwell, TX, located close to the New Mexico border where Highways 60 from Amarillo and 84 from Lubbock converge (about 90 miles from Lubbock). Interestingly, it is named after the brothers who built the state capitol building in Austin. They were compensated by a large area of land that became the XIT Ranch and made their home on the southwest corner of the ranch in what is now Farwell.

After years of being active members at Hope, Pastor Eric Hiner suggested several years ago that maybe it might be time to establish a ministry in Farwell, located about 90 miles from Lubbock, that might serve them and the community. The seed was planted, as was hope in God's Spirit to guide the members at Hope and the families in Farwell...


