From the Pacific Southwest District // News About the Fires: We praise God that **no PSD church or school properties have experienced significant damage** as of this point. Of note is the fact that Palisades Lutheran is the only Christian church still standing in its immediate area. Several churches are serving as community care centers. Lutheran Church Charities K-9 Comfort Dogs and Care Teams are on site providing assistance. LCC is also training people in "Spiritual First Aid."

The most effective ways to help right now are:
