Sandy's Story — God Knows Where They Are

This is my friend Sandy. She is profoundly Deaf and lives right here in Sealy, Texas.

About a year and a half ago, Sandy and I met at a garage sale at my church. At the time, I remember wondering, “Sealy is such a small town. Are there really any Deaf people living here or nearby?” God already knew the answer!

Slowly, Sandy and I began getting to know each other. I invited her to lunch several times, and as our friendship grew, I learned more about her life and how she came to live in Sealy.

Sandy had been away from church for many years, even though she believed in Jesus Christ. I invited her to LifeBridge Community Church, where I had started serving in Deaf ministry.

Little by little, Sandy became involved. She began helping and supporting our Deaf ministry. We also started Deaf Craft together—a place where Deaf and hearing people can gather, enjoy crafts, build friendships, and experience Christian fellowship.

Looking back, I can clearly see God's hand in our friendship. I did not go to that garage sale expecting to meet a Deaf woman who would become an important part of my life and ministry. But God had a plan.

I simply followed where God was leading, and He brought Sandy and me together. Today, Sandy and I are good Christian friends. We encourage each other in our faith, serve together, and enjoy spending time together.

Sometimes churches may wonder, “Are there Deaf people in our community who need to be reached?” We may not see them yet, but God knows exactly where they are.

God brings people together in His time and for His purpose.

What began as a simple meeting at a church garage sale grew into friendship, Christian fellowship, and ministry. Praise God!
